MEET OUR CBE INSTRUCTOR: DR. MANDAR KATHE



This month's Instructor Feature was Dr. Mandar Kathe! Mandar is originally from Bombay, India and completed his undergraduate education at the Institute of Chemical Technology in India. Mandar received his Master's degree and PhD from OSU. In Mandar's career, he has spent about 2-3 years in the Oil and Gas industry, and 2-3 years working as a professor. He feels ambivalent about both, and sees the benefit in both paths. Mandar is currently co-teaching Senior Design and Process Economics, but has taught the Separations course in the past as well. Mandar is extremely passionate about chemical engineering for two main reasons: the potential that ChemE

has to change the world and make it a better place, and, of course, his love of mathematics. In his transition to OSU, Mandar has a great appreciation for the support system OSU provided for him after moving halfway across the world and leaving his family behind.
