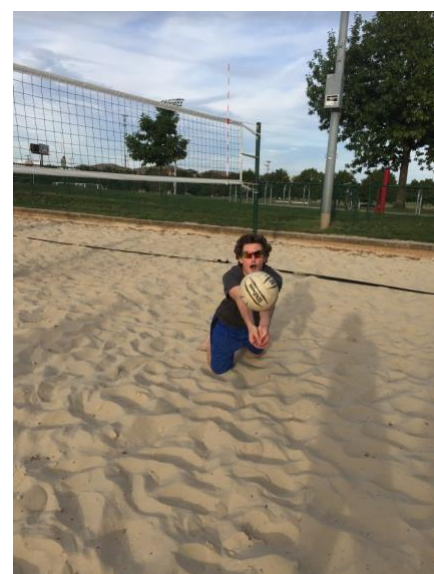
Dow Chemical Info Session
