Editorial Board Descriptions

Editorial Board members are expected to attend events sponsored by *Mosaic*, such as poetry readings, art workshops, field trips, guest lectures, and the end-of-the-year unveiling of the magazine. In addition, all editors must attend weekly meetings, write blog posts for our website, request sponsorship from businesses, volunteer for shifts at the involvement fairs, and assist in event planning. The number beside each description indicates the total editors accepted for that position; however, not all positions may be open at this time.

Editors-In-Chief (2) delegate duties within the Editorial Board and oversee the production of the magazine. They are responsible for coordinating meetings, events, and sponsorship opportunities. Additionally, Editors-in-Chief select members of the Editorial Board and work closely with the group advisor. Please note that only applicants with past experience on the Mosaic staff or editorial board are considered for this position.

Literature Editors (2) evaluate and select literature submissions for publication and coordinate events related to the literary arts. In addition, they must arrange regular meetings with their staff and assist in marketing work. Literature editors should possess an extensive knowledge of proper grammar and be able to recognize quality writing (prose and poetry).

Art Editors (2) evaluate and select art submissions for publication and coordinate events related to the arts. In addition, they must arrange regular meetings with their staff and assist in marketing work. Art editors should possess an extensive knowledge of the elements and principles of design and be able to recognize quality artwork.

Layout Editors (2) design and oversee the physical production of the magazine. Each issue is produced with Adobe InDesign; experience with Adobe Creative Suite and advanced design skills are required. In addition, they must arrange regular meetings with their staff and assist in marketing work.

The **Treasurer** (1) is responsible for the management of *Mosaic* funds. He or she must attend SOURCE training, as well as work with the SOURCE for programming and operating funds. Applicants with previous Treasurer experience are greatly appreciated.

Please provide a detailed list of your time commitments (including work, internships, extra-curricular activities, sports, and study abroad plans) for the 2018-2019 academic year. In the case that you will be spending a large number of hours per week on these other commitments, please explain why this will not interfere with your leadership of *Mosaic*.
- 2. Please list any previous experiences you have had with *Mosaic*.
- 3. *Mosaic* editors must be dynamic, enthusiastic leaders. What leadership experience makes you an excellent candidate for a position on the editorial board?
