Participation in this study involves:

- A 20-minute initial online survey
- A 10-minute online survey in the beginning of the second semester
- A time commitment of 7 minutes per week to complete a weekly online survey for a semester (16 surveys in total for a semester)
- \$10 gift card after completing every four surveys (total \$40 per semester), and \$5 gift card after completing a survey in the beginning of the second semester.
